Daily itinerary

Day 1, Wed. 11th May: Depart London for flight to Tel Aviv. Everyone meets at the airport. Please *wear your badge* so that your leader or All Saints Travel representative can easily identify that you are one of the group travelling. Upon arrival at Tel Aviv airport, your guide and coach will be waiting to transfer to your hotel in Bethlehem [a Catholic Hotel]. Evening dinner at hotel.

Day 2, Thu. 12th May: Depart for Manger Square about 9 am., Mass in St Joseph's Grotto, Franciscan Church of the Nativity, visit the Grotto of the Nativity - where Jesus was born, and afterwards the Milk Grotto - and visit the Museum of the Miracles. Local bus to Shepherd's field, visit Grottos there, and visit Chapel above - *where the angels first sang the 'Gloria in Excelsis Deo' on the night of the first Christmas.* 2:00 p.m. Confessions in Bethlehem, with if possible Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. Shopping in Bethlehem. Return to our hotel.

Day 3, Fri. 13th May: Coach to the summit of the Mt of Olives, Jerusalem; visit Ascension Dome, Pater Noster Grotto, walk to Dominus Flevit [where Jesus wept over Jerusalem], Mass here, and afterwards proceed to Gethsemane Garden and Basilica. Visit the Assumption Church. P.M., coach to Emmaus [el Qubeibeh], and the Old Roman Road, & on to Visitation Shrine, and lastly Birthplace of St John the Baptist. Return to our hotel.

Day 4, Sat. 14th May: Early coach to Jerusalem & to the Old City [Jaffa Gate]. Walk to the Holy Sepulchre Basilica - [the holiest place on earth], visiting Mt Calvary [Mass here], the Holy Tomb of the Resurrection, St Mary Magdalene's Shrine, Blessed Sacrament Chapel [Divine Mercy devotions here, or if possible on Mt Calvary], and visit the Grotto of the True Cross. Tea break. Then walk to the Chapel of the Upper Room [Benediction here if possible]. Visit Upper Room itself; the magnificent Dormition Abbey, & St Peter in Gallicantu's - a truly incredible Shrine, and visiting the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned after His mock trial on Maundy Thursday night. Visit Pilate's Court, Crowning with Thorns, & the Condemnation Chapels followed by Stations of the Cross Via Dolorosa. A Cross is available to carry if desired. Return to hotel.

Day 5, Sun. 15th May: Depart for Bethany visit St Lazarus's Church & proceed to Jericho, view Mt of Temptation & Zacchaeus's Sycamore Tree. Lunch, then depart for the Dead Sea and experience the floating/swimming in the Dead Sea. Return to our hotel.

Day 6, Mon. 16th May: Depart hotel for drive along the Jordan Valley and to Tiberias sail on the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum [ancient re-production boat], and tour here; we also visit Mt of Beatitudes, St Peter's Primacy where Christ appeared to the Apostles after His Resurrection; we will also visit the Church of the Feeding of the 5,000. We now travel to the River Jordan, renewal of Baptismal Vows and proceed to the wonderful imposing Basilica of the Annunciation in Nazareth, viewing the Grotto where the Annunciation took place [Mass here]; and tour of this Basilica, [the finest Church in the Middle East]. We will then visit St Joseph's Workshop. Transfer to our Nazareth Hotel [3 star].

Day 7, Tue. 17th May: Depart for the Annunciation Basilica in Nazareth - and tour of this incredible Basilica, and visit Grotto for Mass, and visit St Joseph's-Workshop. Proceed to Mt Tabor, taxis up the mountain, proceed to Cana for renewal of Marriage Vows. We then drive to the Salesian Basilica of Jesus Adolescence in Nazareth for Benediction & Rosary - this is a superb Basilica [and sadly practically unknown]. We now return to our Nazareth hotel for evening meal, and overnight.

Day 8, Wed. 18th May: Return to the airport of departure and return home.
